
CORONADO MINI TREK

The specialty areas, which guests may visit, include: Elephant Barn, Rhino Barn, Giraffe Barn and the Camel Yard. Two of the above areas will be visited. The areas visited depend upon the animals' health and behavior and will vary from day to day.
