Monday Recreation

Participate in one of several activities planned for your enjoyment on Monday morning, September 8th. Please indicate your choice on the conference registration form. Tours depart from the main entrance of the hotel.

Golf Tournament

The directors' and spouse golf tournaments are both scheduled for the Championship Golf Course at Incline Village/Lake Tahoe which is located a short five minute shuttle ride from the hotel. A limited number of rental clubs are available for \$40 from the pro shop. Contact the pro shop directly to reserve rentals at (775)832-1146 and identify yourself as a player in the NPRA tournament on Monday, September 8.

The Directors' tournament is scheduled to get underway with a 9:00 am shotgun start. Once again, this year's 18-hole tournament will be played in a scramble format. Be sure to indicate your handicap on the registration form.

The Spouse tournament is also scheduled for a 9:00 am shotgun start on Monday morning. The Spouse tournament will again be held concurrently with the Directors' tournament on Monday morning. Please indicate your handicap when you register.

Fee: \$250.

Begin at 9:00 am, conclude at approximately 1:30 pm.

Emerald Bay Hike

This morning, you will first take the most beautiful drive in America around half of the lake for a scenic bus tour of the Lake Tahoe's fabulous shoreline to reach DL Bliss State Park, the starting point of your hike. You will hike part of the Rubicon Trail to Emerald Bay, viewing scenic vistas of the lake, mountains and waterfalls. Photo opportunities abound. You'll then pass and tour Vikingsholm Mansion, a Scandinavian style summer home built by Mrs. Laura Knight in 1929. The home has a unique history and is accessible only by a steep one mile long footpath to the

main road. To learn more about Vikingsholm's history and architecture, click here. At the conclusion of the house tour, you will make the one mile footpath journey up to the parking lot where the bus awaits to take you back to the Hyatt via the other side of the lake.

Fee: \$75, minimum 6 people.

Tour departs at 7:00 am, returns by 1:00 pm. (Note: Departure and return times are tentative at this time.)

Artouring

What is Artouring? When viewing a painting or a sculpture or a piece of jewelry, have you ever wondered how that piece was created or what inspired the artist to produce it, and what kind of background, education, experience and talent it took to produce the piece? Artouring offers a cultural "behind the scenes" look at the artistic community that makes its collective home in the Reno-Tahoe-Virginia City area. Tours take you into the artist's studios that are not normally open to the public, to meet and talk with them and to see their work. This becomes an art and architecture tour. This tour will offer insight into the crafts of a totem pole carver, a jewelry maker, a glass artist, and a watercolorist.

Fee: \$75, minimum 10 people.

Tour departs at 9:00 am, returns by 1:00 pm.

Thunderbird Lodge

The Thunderbird Lodge, a National Register Historic District, was built in 1936 by eccentric San Francisco millionaire George Whittell and later purchased and added to by financier, Jack Dreyfus. It is a remarkable example of the "old Tahoe" architectural style and master craftsmanship. Stone masonry and hand wrought ironwork are found throughout the secluded site's Tudor-revival cottages and along the winding pathways, bridges, secret patios and fountains. You will discover the Lighthouse Room, Old Lodge, the maids' quarters and original kitchen, as well as a trip through the 600' underground tunnel leading to the infamous Card House and Boat House. In the Boat House you may find the fabulous yacht, Thunderbird, built for George Whittell in

1939. The yacht is a one-of-a-kind masterpiece built in a bygone era, a 55' long, John Hacker design with a mahogany hull and dual aircraft engines. You will enjoy breathtaking views of Lake Tahoe and nearby mountain ranges while you enjoy the magic that is Thunderbird Lodge.

Fee: \$75, minimum 10 people.

Tour departs at 9:30 am., returns by 12:30 pm.

Traveling to the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe Resort & Spa

Air

The Reno/Tahoe International Airport is the most convenient airport to the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe Resort and Spa (34 miles).

Ground Transportation Options

The Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe Resort and Spa is located in Incline Village, Nevada, approximately 50 minutes (34 miles) south of the Reno/Tahoe International Airport.

Taxi Cab Service:

Taxis are readily available at the airport for a one way fare of approximately \$85 + tip. It is recommended to arrange return trips to the airport 24 hours in advance of expected departure to assure availability as taxis are not as readily available at the resort as they often are at city hotel locations. If further information is desired, the following taxi companies may be helpful: Reno-Sparks Cab (775-333-3333), Yellow/Deluxe Cab (775-355-5555) or Whittlesea Checker Taxi (775-322-2222).

Private Car Service:

Bell Limousine, (775-323-3727) offers sedan service between Reno International Airport and the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe by pre-scheduled appointment for approximately \$125 each way including gratuity.

Shuttle Service:

North Tahoe Express offers pre-scheduled bus transportation for approximately \$35 one way and \$70 round trip from the Reno airport to the Hyatt. Call (866-216-5222) or www.NorthLakeTahoeExpress.com for schedule information. Note that this option is likely the least convenient.

Rental Car:

If you opt to rent a vehicle, Avis is the official car rental company for the Board of Directors Meeting. To obtain discounted rates, call (800-331-1600) and refer to AWD#: B761399.

Driving Directions:

From the Reno/Tahoe International Airport, take Highway 395 South to the Mt. Rose Highway/Lake Tahoe exit, Highway 431 (exit merges directly onto Highway 431). Highway 431 is a beautiful mountainous drive. Follow Highway 431 until it ends at Highway 28. Turn left onto Highway 28 to third stop light. Turn right onto Country Club Drive at this last stop light. Hotel is at corner of Country Club Drive and Lakeshore Blvd. (111 Country Club Drive, Incline Village, NV 89451).

Registration fees for the meeting are \$950.00 for registrants and \$250.00 for spouses. Hotel rooms are \$220 single/double and incur a \$12.00 per day resort fee. The resort fee includes local calls; 800 access fee; valet parking; health club entrance; safe; in-room bottled water; incoming fax (up to 9 pages); outgoing fax (up to 5 pages); daily newspaper; in-room coffee; complimentary business center services; seasonal ski valet and fitness classes. Reservations must be made by the cutoff date of August 4.

Attire

The resort dress is "resort casual" requiring casual but polished attire anywhere in the resort. Shirts, swimsuit cover-ups and shoes must be worn in all public areas. The golf club requires collared shirts with shorts or slacks, no denim or metal spikes. All meeting functions are resort casual with the exception of the Monday evening dinner dance which is business attire.
