The **Directors' tournament** is scheduled to get underway with an 8:00 am shotgun start. Once again, this year's 18-hole tournament will be played in a scramble format. Be sure to indicate your handicap on the registration form.

The **Spouse tournament** is also scheduled for a 8:00 am shotgun start on Monday morning. The Spouse tournament will again be held concurrently with the Directors' tournament on Monday morning. Please indicate your handicap when you register.

Fee: \$150. Begin at 8:00 am, conclude at approximately 12:30 pm.

Catch a Wave Surf Lesson

Grapes a Plenty - Temecula Valley Wine Tour and Tasting

Join the wine enthusiasts in the group for a tour and tasting at two wineries in the heart of the Temecula Valley Wine Country. The first stop is the award winning [Thornton Winery](#). Resembling a French chateau, this winery utilizes the natural Method Champenoise to add the effervescence to champagne, allowing fermentation in individual bottles. The tasting here will consist of 4 champagne varieties. Just a short distance down the road is our next stop at [Weins Cellars](#). A relatively new facility with the first vineyards planted in 1996 and the winery and tasting room just opening in late 2006, Weins Cellars is a family owned and operated winery which produces a broad range of California gold-medal winning, estate-farmed varietal wines. Here, we will sample three of their offerings.

Fee: \$100 minimum 20 people. Tour departs at 9:00 am.

TRAVELING TO THE [RANCHO BERNARDO INN](#)

Air

The San Diego International Airport is the most convenient airport to the Rancho Bernardo Inn.

Ground Transportation

The Rancho Bernardo Inn is located approximately 30 minutes (25 miles) north of the airport in North San Diego.

Taxi Cab Service: Taxis are available at the airport for a one way fare of approximately \$75 + tip. For return trips to the airport, contact the bell desk at least two hours before expected departure so they can reserve a car from the local cab company. Taxis do not line up at the resort as they often do at city hotel locations.

Shuttle Service: Cloud 9 Shuttle Service offers van service from the airport for \$26 per person each way. Call 1-800-974-8885 to make advance reservations for arrival and departure and advise that you are with NPRA, traveling to the Rancho Bernardo Inn.

Rental Car: If you opt to rent a vehicle, Avis is the official car rental company for the Board of Directors Meeting. To obtain discounted rates, call (800)331-1600 and refer to AWD#: B761399.

Driving Directions: From the San Diego Airport, merge onto I-5S, then merge onto CA-163N via Exit 16 toward Escondido for 10 miles. Then merge onto I-15N for 12 miles. Take the Rancho Bernardo Road exit – Exit 24. Then take the ramp toward Lake Poway. Turn right onto Rancho Bernardo Road. Turn left onto Bernardo Oaks Drive which ends at the Rancho Bernardo Inn, 17550 Bernardo Oaks Drive, San Diego, CA 92128.

Registration fees for the meeting are \$950.00 for registrants and \$250.00 for spouses. Hotel rooms are \$189 single/double and incur a \$15.00 per day resort fee. The resort fee includes in-room coffee/tea service, unlimited local, toll-free and credit card phone calls, unlimited in-room high-speed internet access, newspapers on weekdays and daily access to the spa and fitness center (treatments are additional). Reservations must be made by the cutoff date of August 6.

ATTIRE

The resort dress is “resort casual” requiring casual but polished attire anywhere in the resort. Shirts, swimsuit cover-ups and shoes must be worn in all public areas. The golf club requires collared shirts with shorts or slacks, no denim or metal spikes. All meeting functions are resort casual with the exception of the Monday evening dinner dance which is business attire.
